

LORD'S PRAYER OUTLINE

I. "Our Father which art in Heaven"

- Reaffirm your position, as being a son/daughter of God and that He loves you.
- Reaffirm your position as being forgiven:

Example: *Dear Heavenly Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus. I am so grateful for this day and I know You are with me right now. I know that You love me or else You wouldn't have sent Your Son to die for me. I boldly approach Your throne of Grace right now to receive Your mercy. I am so grateful that Your mercy is new every morning. I thank you that I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus and today I receive your abundance of Grace and the gift of righteousness to reign over every situation in my life through Jesus Christ. I thank You for seeing me through the blood of Christ. I am so grateful that there is forgiveness for me today. I remain teachable and open to Your direction for my life today, Father. I choose to keep short accounts with everyone.*

- Ask for the help of the Holy Spirit

Example: *I ask that Your Holy Spirit guide and lead me today into the truth of Your Word. My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, so I know that You are working through me today. Holy Spirit, lead me into the presence of God to pray the perfect will of the Father today. I trust You. I love You. I know that You are here with me, hearing me as I pray.*

II. Hallowed be thy Name

- Begin with a heart of thanksgiving, with Praise and Worship. As you worship God for who He is, He becomes that in your life!

Example: *I worship You today and thank You for who You are to me. You are everything that I need.*

- Jehovah Tsidkenu — "the Lord our righteousness"
Thank You for being my righteousness; You have made me righteous through Your Son.
- Jehovah-Shalom — "the Lord our peace"
Thank You for being my peace today. You said the peace that passes all understanding would guard my mind through Christ, so I worship You for keeping me in Your perfect peace in every situation that arises today.

- Jehovah-Shammah — "the Lord is present"
Thank You for being my ever-present God. You said You would never leave me or forsake me (Hebrews 1:4). Your perfect Love casts out all fear. No matter what I face today, You are walking through it with me.
- Jehovah-Rapha — "the Lord that heals"
Thank You for being my healer today, Father God. I know that it is You, God, who keeps me healthy. You said that the same Spirit that raised Jesus Christ from the dead dwells in us and quickens our bodies to health. I worship You for making me strong and healthy. I believe that throughout the day Your power is keeping anything from coming against my body.
- Jehovah-Jireh — "the Lord will provide"
Thank You for being my provider. You said that You would provide all of our needs according to Your riches in glory. I worship You and thank You for Your great care in providing every need I have. I know You are working behind the scenes to take care of me. You are my perfect provider.
- Jehovah-Nissi — "the Lord our banner" or "victory"
Thank You for being my Banner of Victory today, Father. You said that if You are for us who can be against us. I am already a winner because You are on my side. I believe You are fighting every battle that comes my way today, for You said the battle is the Lord's and the victory is mine.
- Jehovah-Raah — "the Lord my shepherd"
I worship You for being my great shepherd. You said that the steps of a righteous man are ordered by You. I thank You that You have given me the Holy Spirit who is giving me Your wisdom to follow Your leading today. As my shepherd, I believe You are leading me in great paths of favor today. Thank You for keeping me in Your perfect will.

* This is a great opportunity to put in a Worship CD and simply worship along with the CD.

III. Your Kingdom come Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven

- Expect God's kingdom to come into your sphere of influence: Our country, state, cities, church leadership and family.

Example: *Father I pray Your kingdom come, Your will be done in our county, state and cities. You said in Your Word that I should pray for our leaders so that we would live at peace. Thank You for leading the decision makers in this country, state, and city today, Father God. I declare no weapon formed*

against our leadership shall prosper. I recognize that principalities and rulers of darkness war against our leadership, so I bind them, rendering them harmless and ineffective against our leadership. I thank You for wisdom, courage and strength for our leadership. Father, I believe that Your Holy Spirit is influencing our leaders to follow Your perfect will. I know that as soon as I pray You are working on my behalf, guiding the decisions in this nation today. I declare that Godly men and women are rising into strategic positions of leadership. I declare that You are drawing leaders, who do not know You, to Jesus Christ Your Son.

*Specific names of leaders in your community can be added to your prayer

Example: Father, I pray Your kingdom come Your will be done in my Family. I declare Your favor is on every area of our lives. Your love, joy and peace permeate my home. My family is kept by the power of Your Word. Father I know out of Your great love You are shaping my family, by Your Holy Spirit, to become more and more like You so I can be an extension of Jesus Christ wherever I go. Multitudes of people are coming to the saving knowledge of Christ through my family. As for me and my house we will serve the Lord! Father, I believe You are guiding me, as I make decisions at work, at home, and with my family today. I thank You that those decisions reflect You today.

*Specific names of family members (spouse, children etc...) should be added to your prayer

Example: Father I pray Your kingdom come Your will be done in our church. I declare that our Pastor and leadership is filled with the knowledge of Your will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding. They hear Your voice and the voice of a strange they will not follow. Father You are guiding every decision, lining it up with Your perfect will. I declare that resources are released to grow every area of ministry so we can impact our community for Jesus Christ, causing multitudes to make decisions to follow Christ. I thank You for trusting us to minister to people today, Father. I ask that You touch and increase each ministry area (youth, children's, small groups, men's, women's, etc.). Father, I believe that You are strengthening, upholding and providing for our leadership today. I know that You have growth in mind when it comes to the Body of Christ, so I activate that today. Father I believe that You are touching our members with passionate zeal to touch people for Christ.

*Specific names of leaders in your church community can be added to your prayer

Example: Father, I pray Your kingdom come Your will be done in our workplace today. I thank You that You are giving me Your ideas to better my work place. I choose to treat this company as if it were my own. I thank You for promoting

me! I believe this company is increasing and growing. I thank You for helping me to be a tremendous light to everyone around me so that many will come to know Jesus. Show me ways to witness. You said You would make our lips like the pen of a ready writer, so I thank You for giving me the perfect words and actions in order to add people to the Body of Christ.

IV. Give us this day our daily bread

- Petition God for your specific needs: spiritual, family, physical, emotional, social, material and financial needs.
- Always thank God that you have received what you have prayed for; see it done!

Example: *As You did for the Israelites when You gave them fresh manna every morning, I ask for the same for me today, Father God. Thank You for having Your hand on my physical body, my family, emotional, social, material and financial needs today. Whatever need rises up, I know that You're looking out for us and touching us today.*

This is where we can get specific with the current needs that are perfecting our lives right now. Don't stop speaking God's promises over those areas until you see change!

V. Forgive us our debts as I forgive others

- Examine to see if there is any unforgiveness that needs to be addressed; set our minds to walk in forgiveness.

Example: *Father I know if I have anything in my heart against anyone, it blocks my ability to receive from you. I know You want me to forgive the way I want to be forgiven, so I thank You for showing me anything that may have crept into my heart so that I can forgive and get past it. You work miracles through a clean heart, so I keep an open heart to You. I forgive anyone that may have trespassed against me, and I ask that You show me anyone that may have something against me today, so that I can clear it up. I thank You for Your forgiveness in everything. I recognize that I am human and that You are always in place of forgiveness towards me no matter how difficult the situation is.*

VI. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one

- Praying God's protection and sensitivity to avoid evil

Example: *Father I put on Your full armor today to resist any plans the enemy may have against me. Thank You for Your hedge of protection around me (and*

my family) as I go through my day. I thank You that Your ministering spirits are watching over us and the promises of Psalm 91 protect us.

VII. For Yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever.

- Return to thanksgiving and praise for all God will do for you this day!

Example: *Father I am so grateful the Greater One lives within me. I know that with You I can conquer anything today. I worship You for the honor of walking with You throughout my day, being led by You every step of the way. I thank You and praise You for hearing my heart and for all that has been accomplished in our time together. I praise You for answered prayers in advance. I have faith that You are with me and hearing my every prayer. Thank You again Father, in Jesus Name. Amen.*
